

## Reopening Guidelines for Worship at Holy Trinity

Holy Trinity plans to reopen for worship on August 2nd! We will have two services at 8:30 a.m. and 11:15 a.m. Guidelines and procedures have been developed to ensure the health and safety of all disciples who come to worship. These guidelines and procedures include recommendations from the CDC and Brotherhood Mutual (the church's insurance company). Below is a brief summary of what everyone can expect. ### PLEASE STAY AT HOME IF:

- ✓ you have a cough
  - ✓ you have a fever
  - ✓ you are not feeling well
  - ✓ you have been near someone who has been sick
  - ✓ you think you have been exposed to COVID 19 and have not quarantined for 14 days

- For the sake of our fellow disciples and to comply with our state recommendations, **we ask that everyone wears a mask**, unless you have a health condition that prevents you from wearing one or if you are under the age of 11.
  - We will have one entrance and designated restrooms for each service, and we will work to sanitize any surfaces that are touched.
  - There will be signage and greeters to welcome everyone as they arrive, to assist in the flow of people coming in and out, and to help with our social distancing policy of 6'.
  - A hand sanitation station will be located at the entrances, and we ask that each person use it upon entry into the building.
  - We will ask for everyone to refrain from sharing the peace by shaking hands or hugging for the time being.
  - We will continue to have a children's sermon offered on Facebook on Sunday morning, but we will not be offering Children's Church or the Nursery.
  - A basket will be available to drop offerings in as you come up for communion, or offerings can be made online.
  - In all areas being used, fans will be turned on to increase circulation.
